Ever heard of the Climats? The Climats are specific vineyard plots that have been carefully delimited for centuries. Their geological characteristics and microclimate come together to create remarkable wines with unique organoleptic properties. The two key grape varieties of the region - Pinot Noir and Chardonnay - best express their diversity in Burgundy thanks to the combination of nature and man's experience.

From June 7th to July 7th, Burgundy is celebrating the 4th anniversary of the UNESCO inscription of the Climats. Once more, as one of the great founding sponsors of the inscription application of the Climats, Maison Joseph Drouhin is proud to take part in this one-month-long event. Join us for a visit of our historical cellars (12th and 15th century), followed by the commented tasting of 8 emblematic wines of Maison Joseph Drouhin (4 whites and 4 reds).
